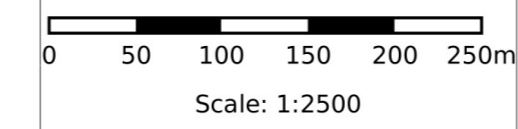

**White Horse Cricket Club** ★



Cricket pitch and clubhouse hosting the White Horse Cricket Club. Hosts social events for the community including a summer ball and quizzes.

**Broad Hinton Village Hall** ★




Community owned and run hall with stage, kitchens and meeting room. Hosts many community clubs and activities, including the BHADS amateur dramatic society, as well as private events and the Post Office once per week.

Popular Italian restaurant and bar.

**Pitchens End Field**




Green area with seating and a path connecting Pitchens End to Post Office Lane. Used by the community for recreation.

**St Peter ad Vincula** †




Grade 1 listed Church of England church dating back to at least the 13th century. The churchyard contains several Grade 2 listed graves and monuments. Has a choir and bellringer group.

**Allotments** ★



Allotments leased from the Horton family and provided by the Parish Council. Has 26 plots and a full membership.

**The Crown** ★



Arkell's tenanted pub and restaurant with large gardens with overarching views of open countryside towards Winterbourne Bassett.

**Broad Hinton Primary School** †



Grade 2 listed, mid-18th century school. Has a catchment area covering the three villages and further afield. The school hall and playing field are available to hire.

**School Playing Field** ★

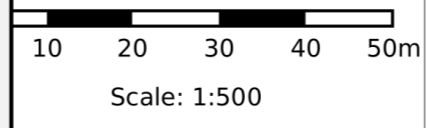


Playing fields owned by Wiltshire Council. Available to the community to hire.

**Village Green**

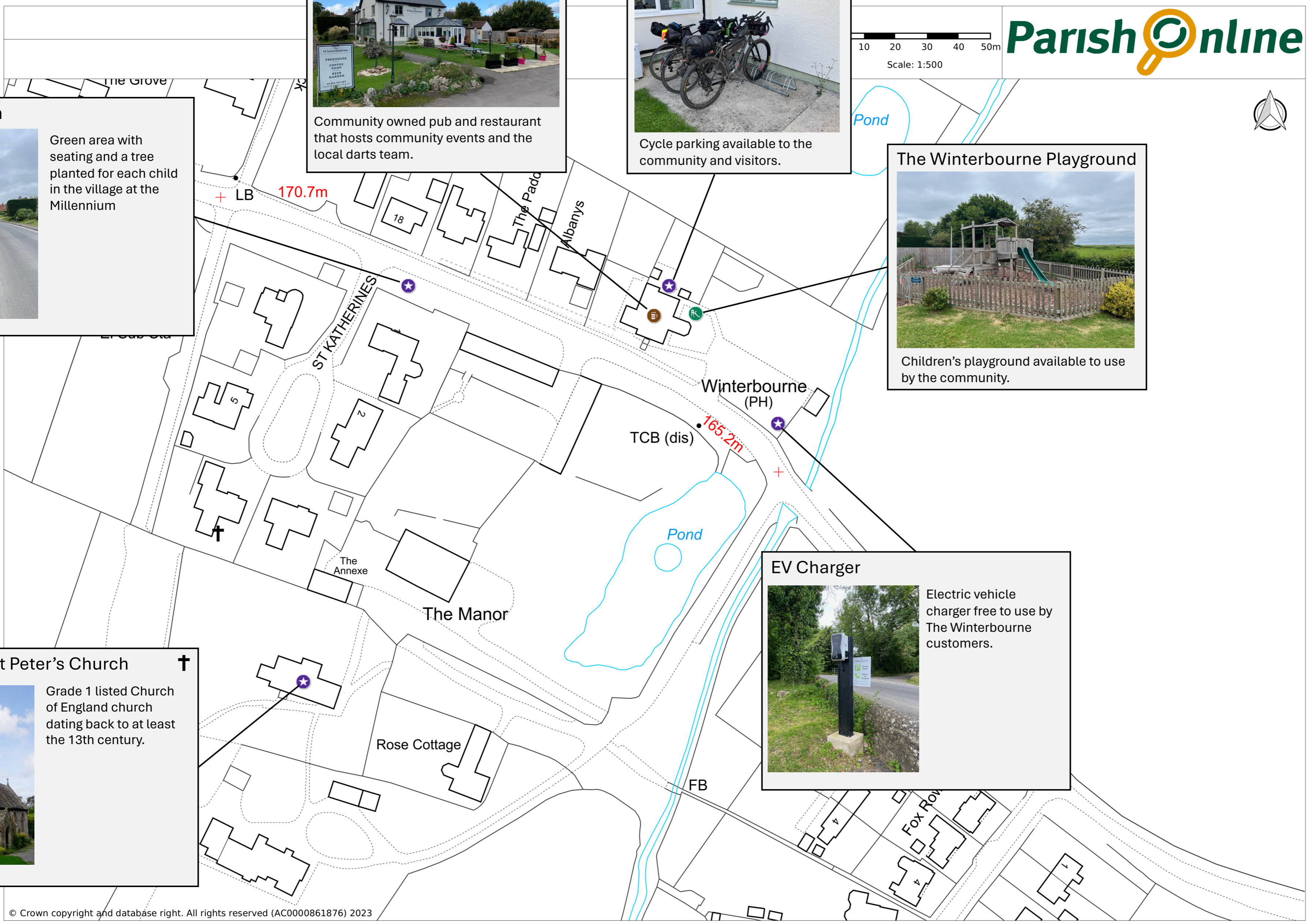


Green area with seating and a tree planted for each child in the village at the Millennium

Grade 1 listed Church of England church dating back to at least the 13th century.

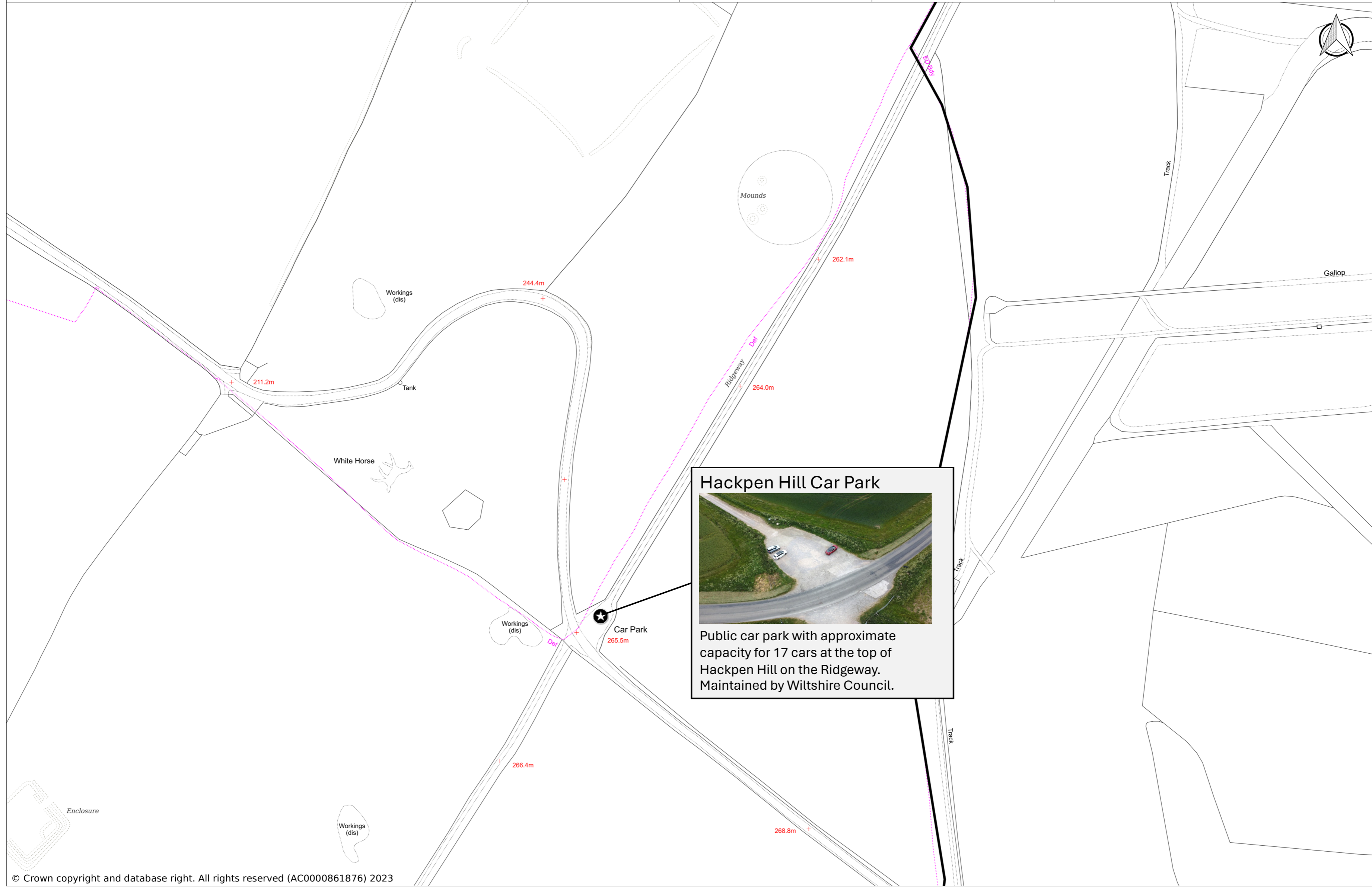
