Objective 2.b. Identify sites for the development of new housing, and other uses, to meet the needs of local people within our community

Policy LHN 1 – Broad Hinton Housing Policy

- Allocation of site B2 for **x** homes with mix of **y** market and **z** affordable homes. Number of bedrooms in range 1 to 4. Map and more details to be determined through landowner engagement.
 - What do you think x, y, and z should be?
- Affordable homes need to prioritise needs of young families moving into the village or young adults moving out of family homes within the parish.
- **N**% of market homes need to prioritise needs of 65+ age groups within the parish that want to downsize from 4+ bedroom homes into spacious homes with less bedrooms and low bills.
 - O What do you think N% should be?
- Condition of development is donating land for amenities and if financially viable, providing one of the amenities on that land.
- Infill supported within Wiltshire Council agreed village development boundary.
- Supportive of community energy projects on sites B1, B3 and B6.

Policy LHN 2 – Winterbourne Bassett Housing Policy

- Supportive of single home infill anywhere between 30mph speed signs, but not in open fields to northwest and north-east of High Street.
 - Is this specific enough or do we need to define a development boundary for Winterbourne Bassett as in Broad Hinton?
- Supportive of a Rural Exception Site of up to 3 Homes on site W3, at least 2 must be Affordable Homes (as per Emerging Local Plan policy).
- No allocated sites for standard development.

Policy LHN 3 – Uffcott Housing Policy

- Supportive of single home infill along through road between New Cottages and Dunsford Farm
